

**PENNSYLVANIA INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AUTHORITY**

**Resolution No. 2018-11**  
**May 22, 2018**

---

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Authority Act for Cities of the First Class (the Act of June 5, 1991, P.L. 9, No. 6, as amended) (the "Act"), and under the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement, dated as of January 8, 1992 (the "Cooperation Agreement"), between the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Authority (the "Authority") and the City of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (the "City"), the City is required to submit a revision to its current Five Year Financial Plan ("Plan") whenever a new labor arbitration award is issued that is not in compliance with such Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a new arbitration award for the International Association of Fire Fighters ("IAFF"), as of May 17, 2018, which is out of compliance with the currently approved FY2018-2022 Plan; and

WHEREAS, under the Cooperation Agreement, the City agreed to submit a revision to its current Plan within twenty (20) days after receipt of a non-complying labor arbitration award; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned timeframe required for a Plan revision in respect of the IAFF arbitration award overlaps with the City's impending submission to the Authority of its new Plan for FY2019-2023 Plan after City Council's forthcoming passage of its FY2019 budget; and

WHEREAS, a revision to the current FY2018-2022 Plan would provide limited financial information and would be out of context with the upcoming FY2019-2023 Plan that the City expects to submit to the Authority in the near future; and

WHEREAS, due to this unique timing, the City has submitted to the Authority a letter requesting that the City not be required to submit a Plan revision for the IAFF arbitration award until the City's submission of its new FY2019-2023 Plan, in which new Plan the City will demonstrate how it will pay for the IAFF arbitration award; and

WHEREAS, the staff of the Authority has reviewed such request of the City and recommends that the Board approve the same;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Authority hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the Authority and the City to defer consideration of the IAFF arbitration award's provisions until the submission by the City of its upcoming FY2019-2023 Plan, and thus waives the requirement that the City submit a revision to its current FY2018-2022 Plan on account of the IAFF arbitration award until such time as the City submits its annual Five-Year Plan for FY2019-2023.

2. All prior resolutions or parts of prior resolutions not in accordance with this Resolution are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
