NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF BOND
RESOLUTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Authority (the "Authority") adopted a resolution on April 20, 2010 (the "Resolution") authorizing the issuance by the Authority of its Special Tax Revenue Bonds (including Bonds) of Philadelphia Funding Program Series of 2010 (the "2010 Bonds") for the purpose of repaying the City of Philadelphia Special Tax Revenue Bonds (City of Philadelphia Funding Program Series of 2009) and paying certain other costs and expenses (including potentially costs of termination of certain contracts, take-or-pay agreements, letters of intent, and other agreements) relating to the refunding pursuant to Section 300(a) of the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Authority Act for Cities of the First Class (the Act of June 5, 1991 (P.L. 877, No. 8) as amended); you are hereby notified that:

1. The Resolution was adopted by the Authority on April 20, 2010.

2. A copy of the Resolution has been filed for public inspection at the office of the Authority at 1800 Walnut Street, 18th Floor, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19102, and at the office of the Chief Clerk of the City Council of the City of Philadelphia (the "City") at Room 402, City Hall, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19107.

3. This notice is published on April 23, 2010.

4. Any action or proceeding of any kind or nature in any court questioning the validity or proper authorization of the 2010 Bonds provided for by the Resolution, or the validity of any covenants, agreements or contract provided for by the Resolution, shall be commenced within 10 days after the publication of this notice.

If no action or proceeding questioning the validity or proper authorization of the 2010 Bonds provided for by the Resolution, or the validity of any covenants, agreements or contract provided for by the Resolution, shall be commenced within 10 days after the publication of this notice, then all residents, taxpayers and owners of property in the City and all other persons whatsoever shall be forever barred and foreclosed from instituting or commencing any action or proceeding in any court, or pleading any defense to any action or proceedings questioning the validity or proper authorization of the 2010 Bonds, or the validity of any covenants, agreements and contracts and the 2010 Bonds and such covenants, agreements and contracts shall be conclusively deemed to be valid and binding obligations in accordance with their terms and tenor.
