NOTICE OF ADDITION OF BOND ISSUANCE
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Authority (the "Authority") adopted a resolution on May 16, 2006 (the "Resolution") authorizing the issuance by the Authority of its Special Tax Revenue Refunding Bonds (City of Philadelphia Funding Program) Series of 2006 (the "2006 Bonds") for the purpose of refunding the Authority's Special Tax Revenue Refunding Bonds (City of Philadelphia Funding Program) Series of 1996 pursuant to Section 303(b) of the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Authority Act for Cities of the First Class (the Act) of June 6, 1981, P.L. 111-16, as amended, which is hereby recited as follows:

1. The Resolution was adopted by the Authority on May 16, 2006.
2. A copy of the Resolution has been filed for public inspection at the office of the Authority at 1429 Walnut Street, 19th Floor, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19102, and at the office of the Chief Clerk of the City Council of the City of Philadelphia (the "City") at Room 402, City Hall, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19107.
3. This notice is published May 22, 2006.

Any action or proceeding of any kind or nature in any court questioning the validity or proper authorization of the 2006 Bonds provided for by the Resolution, or the validity of any covenants, agreements or contracts provided for by the Resolution, shall be commenced within 10 days after the publication of this notice.

If no action or proceeding questioning the validity or proper authorization of the 2006 Bonds provided for by the Resolution, or the validity of any covenants, agreements or contracts provided for by the Resolution, shall be commenced within 10 days after the publication of this notice, then all residents, taxpayers and owners of property in the City and other persons whatsoever shall be forever barred and conclusively deemed to be instituting or commencing any action or proceeding in any court, opposing any defense to any action or proceedings, questioning the validity or proper authorization of the 2006 Bonds, or the validity of any such covenants, agreements and contracts, and the 2006 Bonds and such covenants, agreements and contracts shall be conclusively deemed to be valid and binding obligations in accordance with their terms and tenor.
